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7 WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors has supported the operation of a trauma center as
8 a community service since 1980; and

9 WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors is committed to the operation of a trauma center at

12 Regional Medical Center with selected clinical services identified as major institutional
