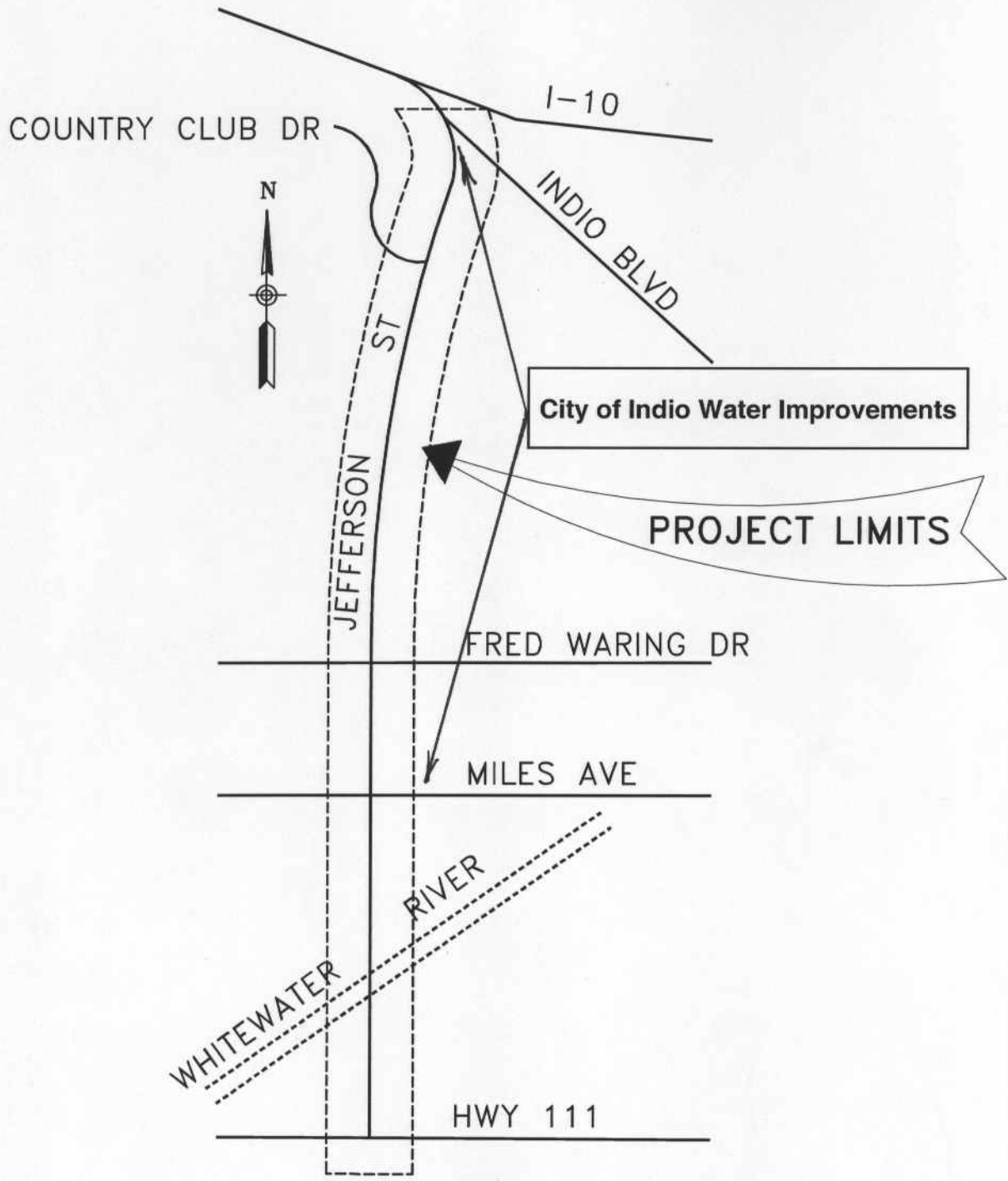

The City of Indio and the Transportation Department believe that combining the work of the two agencies best serves the interest of the public for cost efficiency and to minimize inconvenience to public traffic.

All costs will be borne by the City of Indio.
