BACKGROUND: The Director of Transportation has entered into an emergency contract with the firm of Griffith Company of Santa Fe Springs, California, to perform emergency road and culvert repair work on Lucretia Avenue, south of 66th Street at Day Creek in the West Riverside area. The contract was executed in accordance with authority that the Board has delegated to the Director of Transportation by Resolution no. 93-047, and has been approved as to legal form by County Counsel.

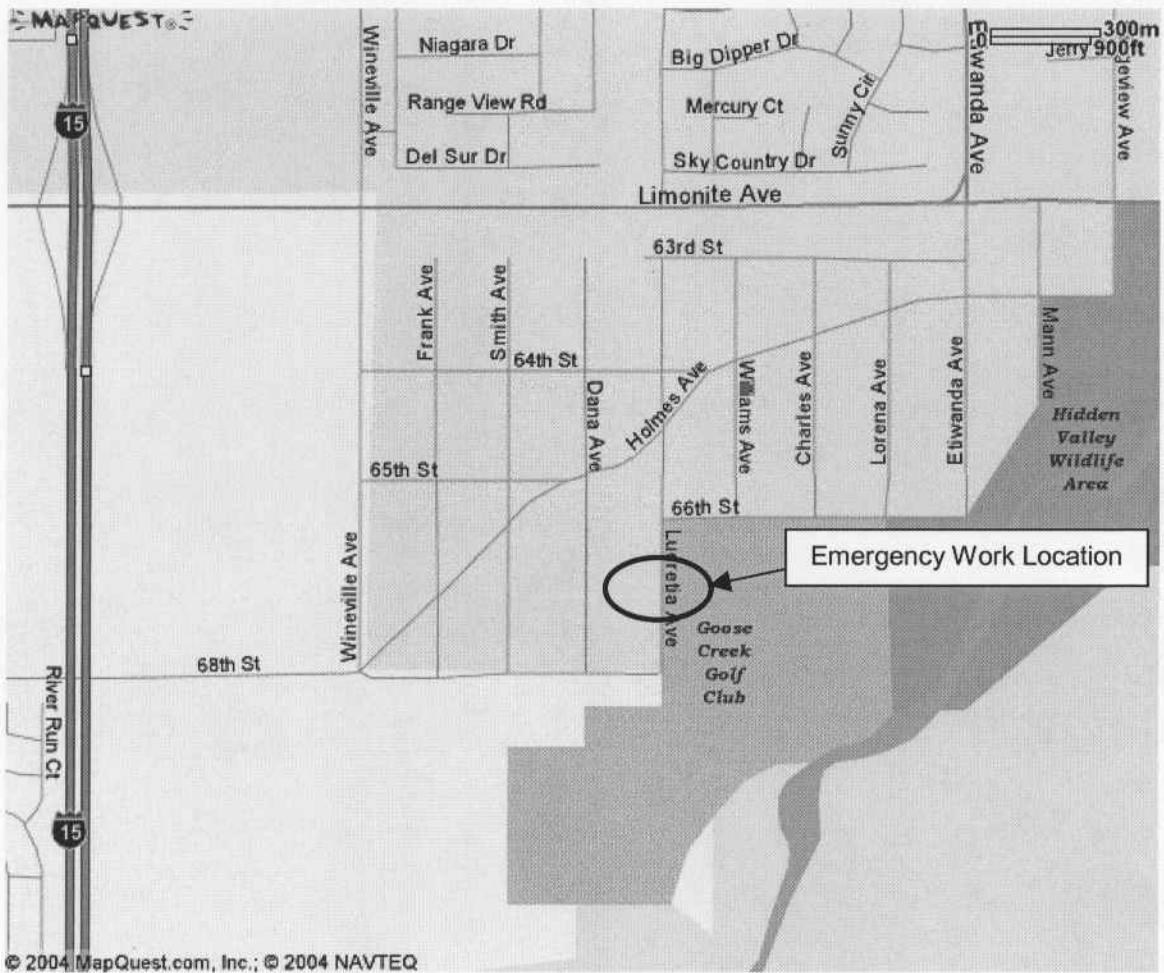

Recent storms have caused damage to the road and culverts at the location where Lucretia Avenue crosses Day Creek. Immediate repair of the damaged roadway and culverts was determined to be necessary to safeguard the motoring public.

The emergency work started on November 16, 2004 and was completed on December 1, 2004.
