SUBJECT: Approval of Agreement between Modern Diagnostics, and Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the attached one (1) year agreement with Modern Diagnostics in the amount of \$200,000.00 pursuant to the applicable California Code;
2. Authorize the Chairman to execute the agreement ; and
3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to exercise the option to renew for up to two (2) additional one (1) year periods, for a total of three (3) years.

BACKGROUND: RCRMC currently utilizes Modern Diagnostics for its intra-operative monitoring services. The intra-operative monitoring services are requested by RCRMC's surgeons for the monitoring of patients while in surgery. These services include experienced and certified Evoked Potential Technologists and the equipment to perform intra-operative studies. Modern Diagnostics provides for services as needed, twenty four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week, and three hundred sixty five (365) days a year.

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BACKGROUND (Continued):

Due to the increased volume of surgeries, lack of available technologists and cost associated with purchase of equipment it was determined to be more cost effective to contract for these professional services. Therefore RCRMC, with County Purchasing's assistance, issued a formal Request for Proposal (RFP), PUARC371 to test the market.

JUSTIFICATION:

RFP, PUARC371 was sent to two (2) vendors and advertised on the County Web Site. Of the two responses, only the Modern Diagnostics proposal was determined to be responsive and responsible by the RCRMC evaluation team.

PRICE REASONABLENESS:

Modern Diagnostics provides like service to the medical community at large and it was determined through reference checks that the vendor is offering RCRMC the same prices offered to comparable customers.
