RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Approve the Cooperative Agreement between the District, the County of Riverside and the Redevelopment Agency of the County of Riverside; and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the District.

BACKGROUND:

The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the Redevelopment Agency is to construct stormwater drainage improvements along Armstrong Road in the Pedley area. Upon completion of the storm drain construction, the District will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the mainline storm drain and the County will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the associated catch basins, connector pipes and laterals.

The Redevelopment Agency will administer the construction contract. The District and Transportation will inspect the construction of their respective facilities.
