**BACKGROUND:** The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the Hemet Master Drainage Plan Line D, Stage 6 storm drain is to be constructed by the District in advance of the construction of certain street improvements along Stetson Avenue proposed by the Hemet Unified School District.

Upon completion of the project construction, the District will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the mainline storm drain and major laterals.
