RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board approve the Cooperative Agreement between the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District), the County of Riverside (Transportation) and the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside (Redevelopment Agency) which sets forth the terms and conditions by which the referenced project will be funded, constructed, operated and maintained, and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Redevelopment Agency.

BACKGROUND:

On October 26, 2004, the Board approved a project budget of \$6,265,513 and awarded the construction contract to the lowest responsible bidder. The attached Agreement is necessary to formalize the provisions by which the project will be designed, funded, constructed, inspected, operated and maintained.

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BACKGROUND Continued:

Upon completion of the project, the District will assume operation and maintenance responsibilities for the mainline storm drain facility. Transportation will assume the operation and maintenance responsibilities of the minor storm drain facilities, any street improvements and all inlets, catch basins, laterals, and connector pipes located within County rights of way.

County Counsel has approved this Agreement as to legal form.
