SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. 2005-034: Indio Hills Community Council and County Service Area 105 Advisory Council

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve Resolution No. 2005-034 combining the Indio Hills Community Council and CSA 105 Advisory Committee.

District # 4

JUSTIFICATION: The Indio Hills Community Council was established in 2001. Community Councils have been established in several unincorporated communities in eastern Riverside County and have proven very successful in providing input to the Board of Supervisors on matters of concern to the residents. This Council serves the purpose of advising the Board on matters pertaining to public health, safety, welfare, public works and planning.

The County Service Area ("CSA") 105 Advisory Committee was established in 1974 for the purpose of road improvement and maintenance, fire protection, police protection, recreation and park services and flood control. The committee has successfully advised the Board and recommended the annual budget for said area.

In order to enhance attendance at both CSA #105 and Indio Hills Community Council meetings, and to ensure a full panel is always in place, it is recommended that the two organizations be combined as one six-member panel. The current members of both councils are in favor of the change, and will continue to serve on the newly combined entity, which shall be known as Indio Hills Community Council.


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1 appointed members of the Council: Michael Lewis, Estelle Dahl, Debra Scriven,
2 Benjamin Bluemm, Ronald Fiero, and Russell Joseph. To comply with Riverside County
3 Board of Supervisor Policy No. A-51, the membership of this Council shall be reduced to
only five members starting on October 1, 2006.

4 3. TERM OF APPOINTMENT: Terms of office for members shall be four
5 (4) years expiring on September 30 of the appropriate years and subsequent new terms
6 shall begin October 1 of that year. The terms of office shall be staggered so that no more
than two thirds (2/3) of the terms of the total number of members of the Committee shall
expire in any one (1) year period.

7 The above named individuals shall continue with their appointed terms on
8 this Council with the following changes. The term of appointment for Michael Lewis and
9 Estelle Dahl shall expire on September 30, 2006. The term of appointment for Debra
Scriven shall expire on September 30, 2007. In addition, the term of appointment for
Benjamin Bluemm, Ronald Fiero, and Russell Joseph shall expire on September 30, 2008.

10 4. OFFICERS: The Committee shall elect from among its members a
11 Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, and Secretary-Treasurer who shall serve for a term of one
year. The term of all officers shall expire on September 30 of each year.

12 5. MEETINGS: Meetings of the Committee shall be subject to the Ralph M.
13 Brown Act (Government Code Section 54950, et. seq.).
