SUBJECT: Emergency Protection of the River Road Bridge over the Santa Ana River, Norco area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors extend the spending authority of the Director of Transportation up to the amount of \$600,000 with respect to the emergency contract entered into by Riverside County Transportation Department with the firm of KEC Engineering.

BACKGROUND: The Director of Transportation has entered into an emergency contract with the firm of KEC Engineering of Corona, California, to provide emergency protection work for the River Road Bridge over the Santa Ana River. The contract was executed in accordance with authority that the Board has delegated to the Director of Transportation by Resolution no. 93-047, was approved as to legal form by County Counsel, and was received and filed by the Board of Supervisors on November 30, 2004 (agenda item 3.28).

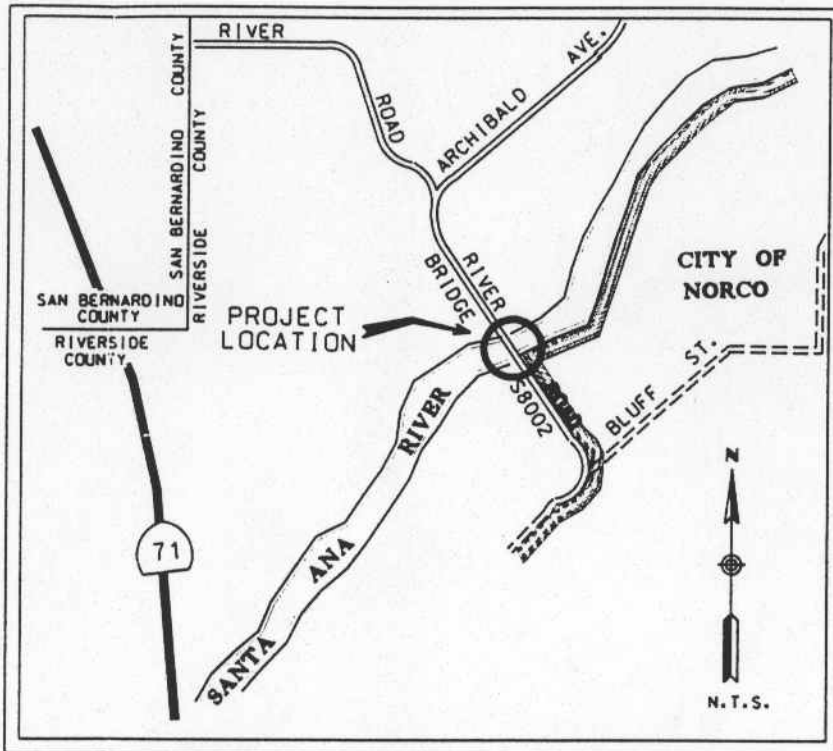

Due to extensive storm activity and additional damage to the bridge and the adjacent roadway for which emergency repairs are underway, projected costs for the emergency work will exceed the Transportation Director's emergency contract authority of \$300,000 as set forth in Resolution 93-047.

It is in the best interest of the motoring public that the bridge and road repairs and the removal of accumulated debris that threatens the bridge structure continue to be performed by the firm of KEC which has equipment and personnel mobilized on-site.
