SUBJECT: Setting the Public Hearing for the One Year Action Plan of the Five Year Consolidated Plan for Community Planning and Development Programs

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors schedule a public hearing for March 22, 2005 at 1:30 pm to obtain views of citizens on community development and housing needs for the County of Riverside 2005-2006 One Year Action Plan of the Five Year Consolidated Plan.

BACKGROUND: A Consolidated Plan is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in order for the County to receive federal funds under the CDBG, HOME, Emergency Shelter Grant, and several other federal programs.

The County's 2005-2006 One Year Action Plan annually identifies the activities which address housing and community development needs identified in the County's 2004-2009 Consolidated Plan.

JUSTIFICATION:

In September of 2004, the Economic Development Agency initiated its Citizen Participation process by notifying Cooperating Cities, community members, public and private agencies of the 2005-2006 One Year Action Plan of the Five Year Consolidated Plan. The County and Cooperating Cities held public meetings to report on their CDBG performance, anticipated funding and to request citizen input in identifying housing and community development needs. Participants in the various meetings were also encouraged to submit proposals for funding to address the community needs.

To comply with the federal requirements in the preparation of the 2005-2006 One-Year Action Plan, a public comment period will open February 17, 2005, and will end March 22, 2005. The Public Hearing on March 22, 2005 is an opportunity for citizens to provide verbal comment on the County of Riverside 2005-2005 One-Year Action Plan. Public Notice requirements regarding the requested March 22, 2005 public hearing have been fulfilled by the Economic Development Agency

It is anticipated that the Board of Supervisors will adopt the 2005-2006 One Year Action Plan at its regular meeting on May 3, 2005. The 2005-2006 One Year Action Plan will then be forwarded to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on May 16, 2005 for final review and approval.
