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Assistance Program

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**BACKGROUND:**

In 2004, the Board approved LIHEAP agreements and amendments with CSD to accept program year 2004 funding to: 1) assist low-income consumers with high energy bills, 2) repair or replace furnaces and other heating devices that contribute to high energy consumption, and 3) weatherize homes. This Agreement #05B-5283 establishes program year 2005 and would continue to provide the same services.

Although the state has not yet received the official 2005 LIHEAP allocation notification from the federal government, this Agreement is being fully funded. If there is a change in funding, this Agreement may be amended.

The Director of DPSS-DCA requests the Board to approve this Agreement #05B-5333 covering the term January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:** No County General Funds will be required.
