BACKGROUND (Cont.)

These additional services are necessary to allow for current and future revitalization activities in the Downtown Mecca area. Pursuant to Government Code 25210.31, the Board of Supervisors may add extended services within an established CSA if determined to be a public convenience and necessity. The adoption of Resolution No. 2005-066 will authorize CSA 97 to provide the aforementioned extended services.

3 AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF
4 EXTENDED SERVICES WITHIN COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 97

6 **WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 25210.4 and 25210.31(1) authorizes the County
7 to provide extended services within an established County Service Area; and

8 **WHEREAS**, it has been requested that park maintenance and landscape maintenance be
9 added to the extended benefits provided by County Service Area 97; and

11 **WHEREAS**, a public hearing was held by the Board of Supervisors on March 1, 2005,
12 after which this Board determined that public convenience and necessity requires that extended
13 services be added to County Service Area 97.

14 **NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
15 Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on March 1, 2005, that extended
16 services of park maintenance and landscape maintenance should be added to County Service
17 Area 97.

18
19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that such extended services shall be provided locally
20 within the geographical boundaries of County Services Area 97, and that such payment for said
21 extended services shall be made from an assessment collected pursuant to Government Code
22 Section 25210.77 (a).
