SUBJECT: Ratify the Second Amendment to the Agreement between San Bernardino County, Department of Health and County of Riverside Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health for the Ryan White Care Act (Contract 03-732).

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the Second Amendment to the Agreement between San Bernardino County, Department of Health and the County of Riverside Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health in the increased amount of \$386,239 and total amount of \$1,012,986; from July 1, 2003 to February 28, 2005; and
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson to sign five (5) originals of said Agreement on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: The Ryan White CARE Act was enacted in 1990 to provide federal funding for comprehensive health and social services for persons living with the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV). The federal Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) provide funding through Title I of the Ryan White CARE Act to areas disproportionately affected by the HIV epidemic.

Subject: Ratify the Amendment to the Agreement between San Bernardino County, Department of Health and County of Riverside Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health for the Ryan White Care Act (Contract 03-732).

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BACKGROUND: (Continued)

Riverside County Department of Public Health has been receiving Ryan White CA Title I funds since 1993, to provide out patient ambulatory medical care for people living with HIV. At this time there are 285 patients receiving medical care at Riverside Neighborhood Health Center. These funds pay for physical examinations, lab testing, and nutritional health education, and psycho social assessments. A portion of funds from this amendment will be used to continue providing HIV medical care and treatment.

This amendment also includes funds to cover the costs of staff to support the Inland Empire HIV Planning Council. The Inland Empire HIV Planning Council requires staff to meet their legislatively mandated duties. These duties include, prioritizing and allocating Ryan White funds, assessing the needs of people living with HIV, and assessing the administrative mechanisms of the grantee. Riverside County provides staff support through the Intergovernmental Agreement signed by both Riverside and San Bernardino Counties.

JUSTIFICATION FOR DELAY: The Department of Public Health recently received this agreement from San Bernardino County. This Form 11 and attachments were subsequently submitted through the County's approval process.
