In a proactive campaign to reduce the number of alcohol involved traffic collisions, the City of San Jacinto has requested that the Sheriff's Department add one Sheriff's Corporal position to the City police force. This position will fulfill duties in late night traffic enforcement and collision investigation with a primary focus on the apprehension of suspected DUI drivers. On February 17, 2005 the City's Mayor executed the Second Amendment to its Agreement for law enforcement services with the County to reflect this new level of service. All costs for this service addition will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Under the current terms of the Sheriff's law enforcement contracts, any rate changes approved by the Board shall take effect on the same date as the County incurs the associated costs. Any contract in effect when changes are approved will have those changes incorporated into the service rate charges.

The 800 MHz radio equipment specified conforms to selected County Technology Standards and will be purchased through the Information Technology Department.


