**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

Approve the Construction Services Agreement (Agreement) between the District and Kemmis Equipment; authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the District; and direct the Purchasing Department to issue the appropriate Purchase Order on behalf of the District.

**BACKGROUND:**

Recent storm events have deposited a significant amount of sediment and debris into the District's Wasson Canyon Debris Basin. The District has selected Kemmis Equipment to remove approximately 20,000 cubic yards of material from the facility.

**FINANCIAL:**

Kemmis Equipment submitted the lowest bid price of \$4.60 per cubic yard of material removed. The total amount paid to Kemmis under this contract shall not exceed ninety-nine thousand dollars (\$99,000.00). Sufficient funds are included in the District's Zone 3 Maintenance budget for FY 2004-05.


