SUBJECT: Ratify the Agreement between the County of Riverside Community Health Agency (CHA), Department of Public Health and the Riverside Community Health Foundation (RCHF) for the Miles of Smiles Dental Program.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify the Agreement No. 05-061 between the County of Riverside Community Health Agency (CHA), Department of Public Health and the Riverside Community Health Foundation (RCHF) for the Miles of Smiles Dental Program in the amount of \$116,660 for the period of July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005;
2. Authorize the Chairperson to execute four (4) copies of said Agreement on behalf of the County;

BACKGROUND: The Miles of Smiles Dental program targets elementary schools with greater than 55% student enrollment in the Federal Free and Reduced School Lunch Program in Riverside. The program has three objectives: (1) oral health education; and (2) the screening and evaluation of at-risk children; and (3) the placement of dental sealants for targeted students.

SUBJECT: Ratify the Agreement between the County of Riverside Community Health Agency (CHA), Department of Public Health and the Riverside Community Health Foundation (RCHF) for the Miles of Smiles Dental Program.

Oral Health Education

Oral health education will be accomplished through a Dental Health Fair format or classroom instruction. The major emphasis will be on oral hygiene through the proper method of brushing, flossing, and nutrition. A case manager will link children to available dental treatment services.

Screening and Evaluation

With parental consent, all children in the school will receive a visual dental screening performed by the school nurse. Children in the 2nd, 5th, and 6th grades will receive a more in-depth dental exam performed by a dentist. The dentist will determine the appropriateness of dental sealants during these in-depth examinations.

Placement of Dental Sealants

Children who need dental sealants and have dental insurance will be referred to their dental provider for treatment. Children who need dental sealants and who are uninsured will receive sealants via this project.

Justification for Delay: Contract received from Riverside Community Health Foundation in early November, 2004. This Form 11 and attachments were subsequently prepared and submitted to County Counsel and through the County approval process.
