SUBJECT: Request for Authorization to Pay Flood Emergency Costs

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Authorize the District to pay KEC Engineering for all work done to stabilize the north bank of the Santa Ana River at Riverview Drive and Avenue Juan Diaz.

BACKGROUND:

Runoff from the large storm system of January 9, 10 and 11, 2005 caused severe erosion along the north bank of the Santa Ana River at Riverview Drive and Avenue Juan Diaz. The erosion threatened public and private property along Riverview Drive. KEC Engineering was brought in on an emergency basis to place 1-ton riprap in an effort to armor the stream bank and halt the erosion. Costs associated with this emergency work is \$115,397.00.
