**SUBJECT:** Ratify the 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment to Renewal Agreement with Second Harvest Food Bank, FY 2004/05 for Brown Bag Program.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment to renewal agreement with Second Harvest Food Bank.
- 2) Authorize Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement.
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original copy and return two (2) copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

**BACKGROUND:** The 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment to Renewal Agreement with Second Harvest Food Bank, covering the period July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, in the reimbursable amount of \$20,405 reflects \$5,105 increased funding for Brown Bag Program. This program consists of providing a variety of surplus and donated edible produce and food products to low-income seniors, distributed on a regular basis, in areas targeting large populations of older individuals for seniors of Corona, Norco, Lake Elsinore, Riverside, Moreno Valley, Perris, Murrieta, Temecula, Banning, Beaumont, Hemet and San Jacinto.

This agreement has been approved as to form by the Office of County Counsel.
