**SUBJECT:** Construction of ramp widening and installation of additional lanes, Interstate 15 at Limonite Avenue, Mira Loma area

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the widening of on and off ramps and the installation of additional lanes at the Interstate 15 and Limonite Avenue interchange in the Mira Loma area of Riverside County. Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, May 4, 2005, at which time bids will be opened.

**BACKGROUND:** The 2004-2005 Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of the subject improvements. The existing Interstate 15 and Limonite Avenue interchange is in need of capacity improvements to accommodate the fast growing Eastvale / Mira Loma area.

The project will provide additional interchange capacity by adding lanes on each of the on and off ramps, and dual left turn lanes and dedicated right turn lanes on Limonite Avenue at the on-ramps, and associated improvements, including traffic signal modifications. The improvements are an interim solution to meet the current and near-term traffic needs. The Transportation Department is working with Caltrans on the preparation of a Project Study Report for the ultimate reconstruction of the interchange to accommodate long-term traffic growth. No significant increase in the County's share of the operating costs for the traffic signal system is anticipated.

The Transportation Department is in the process of finalizing a funding agreement for this work between County Transportation, the Economic Development Agency, and the developer of the commercial project at the northwest quadrant of the interchange. The agreement will be brought to the Board for review and approval prior to award of the construction contract.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel. Environmental clearance is complete.
