
RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board:



BACKGROUND: (Continued)

The purpose of the canopies is to protect County vehicles from deterioration and damage due to harmful ultraviolet rays and from summertime temperatures of over 100 degrees Fahrenheit.

The Department of Facilities Management will return to the Board for their approval of design and specifications, and to initiate the bidding process for the project's construction phase. The order of magnitude cost is \$160,000 for this project.
