The City of Temecula has requested that the Sheriff's Department add three fully-supported Deputies for a Community Policing Team and two Motor Deputies. On April 26, 2005, its City Council authorized execution of the Eighth Amendment to its Agreement for law enforcement services with the County to reflect this new level of service. All costs for this service addition will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form. Since this Amendment is being executed so late in the fiscal year, the Sheriff's Department does not recommend any budget adjustments. Staff estimates the FY 2005-06 budget for this service addition will amount to \$568,000.

The 800 MHz radio equipment specified conforms to selected County Technology Standards and will be purchased through the Information Technology Department.


