**SUBJECT:** Truck Routing and Parking Regulation Study

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Receive and File

**BACKGROUND:** On April 6, 2004 your Board directed the Transportation Department to solicit proposals from qualified professionals for the purpose of commencing a study to guide the County in establishing commercial vehicle weight restrictions as well as big rig and commercial service truck parking restrictions on County maintained roadways. Subsequently, a contract was awarded to Meyer, Mohaddes Associates, in collaboration with Webb Associates and the Tioga Group. The consultant team has been working with County staff and trucking industry experts over the past several months to complete their analysis and prepare recommendations on these complex and multifaceted issues.

The attached report represents the culmination of these efforts. The report includes an overview of the issues identified over the course of this study, a toolbox approach to addressing various issues, and recommendations for further consideration. One recommendation which your Board has already acted upon was the inclusion in the County's 2005 State Legislative Platform of a position relative to Goods Movement Impacts in Riverside County. Other recommendations address such issues as truck parking, truck routing and truck idling. The implementation of some of these recommendations would require the development and adoption of new county ordinances. Others call for improved communication and coordination among affected jurisdictions and truck operators.

Staff recommends that your Board receive and file the final report, as attached, and direct County staff to follow up on the recommendations for implementation.
