SUBJECT: Offer of Reward for Murder of Dominic Redd – Centennial High School Student


RECOMMENDED MOTION:

- (1) That the Board of Supervisors offer a reward in the amount of \$15,000 from the Youth Protection Trust Fund, for information leading to the apprehension and arrest of individuals responsible for the death of Dominic Redd, 15 year old Freshman at Centennial High School in Corona;
- (2) Approve the use of \$15,000 from the Youth Protection Fund;
- (3) Direct the Auditor to transfer \$15,000 from the Youth Protection Fund to the Board of Supervisors Special Programs Expense as follows:

**BACKGROUND:** On Wednesday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, Dominic Redd, a 15-year old Freshman at Centennial High School in Corona, was chased down in his condominium project by 3 assailants, also thought to be of the same age. Dominic was stabbed multiple times in the upper torso and subsequently died of his wounds two hours later. It is not known whether the attack and ultimate murder was race related, however, any such attack on a young student by other juveniles cannot be tolerated. We must do what we can to assist the Corona Police Department in their investigative efforts to apprehend those responsible. I strongly encourage the Board's support.
