BACKGROUND: Under our agreement with California Department on Aging (CDA) One Time Only (OTO) funds can be used for the following purposes:

- Purchase of equipment which enhances the delivery of services to the eligible population
- Home and Community based projects, as approved by CDA
- Innovative pilot projects, as approved by CDA

The One Time Only (OTO) Agreement with Partnership to Preserve Independent Living for Seniors and Persons with Disabilities in the reimbursable amount of \$5,000 provides funds to develop and distribute a Spanish Newsletter for seniors of Riverside County.



BACKGROUND: (continued)

The Spanish Newsletter targets seniors with the greatest social need in Riverside County. Spanish senior 60 years of age or older with a language barrier will be provided information on home and community-based services, volunteer opportunities, transportation, adult day care, legal services, in-home support, ombudsman services, congregate and home-delivered meals, offered by the Riverside County Office on Aging.

The services outlined in this agreement are funded through Older Americans Act, Title III-B, and have been approved by California Department on Aging (CDA), Riverside County Office on Aging Advisory Council and Leadership Team. There are no additional match requirements and no impact to the County General Fund.

This agreement has been approved as to form by the Office of County Counsel.

No additional County funds are being requested for this agreement.
