RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:


- 1) Ratify the attached One Time Only Agreement with Riverside San Bernardino County Indian Health, Inc.

BACKGROUND: Under our agreement with California Department on Aging (CDA) One Time Only (OTO) funds can be used for the following purposes:

- Purchase of equipment which enhances the delivery of services to the eligible population
- Home and Community based projects, as approved by CDA
- Innovative pilot projects, as approved by CDA

One Time Only Agreement with the Riverside San Bernardino County Indian Health, Inc., covering current fiscal year, reflects \$2,510 in reimbursable funds from Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP).

SUBJECT: Ratify One Time Only Agreement FY 2004/05 with Riverside San Bernardino County Indian Health, Inc., Nutrition Program in Districts 3, 4, 5.

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BACKGROUND: (continued)

Nutrition Services Incentive Program funds are for the purchase of foods used in the preparation of congregate and home-delivered meals by nutrition services programs. This OTO agreement is for the provision of, events and occasions, meal services to senior 60 years of age or older, to remain healthy and independent as long as possible; and to promote social interaction.

The services outlined in this agreement are funded through the Older Americans Act, Title III C1 and C2, Congregate and Home Delivered Meals, and support the goals and objectives of the Office on Aging's four-year Strategic Plan, approved by both the Office on Aging Advisory Council and the Board of Supervisors.

This agreement has been approved as to form by the Office of County Counsel.

No additional County funds are being requested for this agreement.
