BACKGROUND: Adoption of Resolution No. 2005-233 appoints the Director of the Transportation Department as the Engineer to prepare a Report regarding the proposed annexation of Zone 49 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated ("L&LM District No. 89-1-C").

Resolution No. 2005-234 declares the Board's intention of ordering the annexation of Zone 49 to L&LM District No. 89-1-C. Annexation of Zone 49 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C will fund the maintenance and servicing of catch basin filtration system improvements within public rights of way located northerly of Craig Ave. in the Menifee area and includes 192 single-family residential lots.

The proposed budget of fiscal year 2005-06 for Zone 49 is \$1,550.00 that will result in an assessment for fiscal year 2005-06 within Zone 49 of \$8.06 per parcel. The annual assessment will be adjusted annually by the greater of 2% or the cumulative percentage increase in the CPI-U, if any, as it stands as of March of each year over the base index for March of 2005.

Consistent with the Board's direction regarding compliance with Article XIID of the California Constitution and the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, the attached resolutions have been prepared and a public hearing scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on July 12, 2005 to receive testimony for and against the proposed assessment. Each property owner within the proposed Zone 49 will receive a notice of the public hearing and mail-in ballot, an impartial analysis, a copy of Resolution No. 2005-234 and an information sheet.

Ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing. If, at the time designated for the tabulation of the ballots, the ballots submitted in favor of the annexation and levy of the assessment exceed the ballots submitted in opposition of said annexation and levy, Zone 49 will be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C.

There is only one individual/entity which owns all of the property within the proposed boundaries of Zone 49 and said property owner has executed a "Waiver and Consent Regarding Date of Assessment Ballot Election" allowing for the election and public hearing to be held on July 12, 2005.
