

FINDINGS AND DETERMINATION THAT AN ITEM MAY BE SUBSEQUENTLY
ADDED TO THE AGENDA OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS



The BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of Riverside County hereby finds:

- That there is need to place an item on the agenda for action by the Board of Supervisors.
 - An emergency situation exists as defined in Government Code Section 94956.5 in that:
 - (a) Work Stoppage or other activity which severely impairs public health, safety, or both, as determined by a majority of the members of the legislative body.
 - (b) Crippling disaster which severely impairs public health, safety, or both, as determined by a majority of the members of the legislative body.
 - The item on which the action is to be taken came to the attention of the county subsequent to the agenda being posted and there is a need to take immediate action on the item.
 - The item was continued for no more than five calendar days from a prior meeting for which the item was posted.

JUSTIFICATION:

There is a new, late development in the State's Medi-Cal Redesign which may call for some immediate Board action on a resolution, possibly even as early as tomorrow, since there is no Board meeting next week on May 31st.

A proposed resolution has been drafted for County Board to consider, which would urge the State to remain firm, and spell out that for a deal to be acceptable, it must both protect current revenue, and provide for adequate growth throughout the 5 year plan.
