SUBJECT: Radiation Therapy Medical Services Agreement between the County of Riverside and Valley Radiotherapy Associates Medical Group, Inc.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the Radiation Therapy Medical Services Agreement effective January 1, 2005; and
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson to sign three (3) copies of the Agreement;; and
- 3) Retain one (1) copy and return two (2) copies of the executed Agreement to Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) Administration for distribution.

BACKGROUND: Radiation Therapy Medical Group is a long time provider for the Hospital's patients that required Radiation Therapy medical services, which were not available on-site from the Hospital. Recently, Valley Radiotherapy Associates Medical Group, Inc. has acquired Radiation Therapy Medical Group and the name of the Radiation Therapy Center has been changed to Vantage Radiation Oncology Center. Dr. Ramez Farah continues as the Medical Director for the facility and maintains his attendance at the Hospital's weekly tumor board meetings.

As a result of this acquisition, a new agreement was arranged with the new Administrators for the facility. In addition to the Riverside location, Valley Radiotherapy Associates Medical Group, Inc. has multiple offices throughout the Inland Empire including Riverside, Wildomar and Temecula where patients referred by the Hospital may receive their Radiation Therapy services.

This Agreement has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel.
