SUBJECT: Addition of Two Vehicles to the Sheriff's Fleet

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve a limited-term donation of two vehicles by the Interinsurance Exchange of the Automobile Club to the Riverside Auto Theft Interdiction Detail (RAID).
2. Authorize the Chairperson to execute the Vehicle Transfer Agreement on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: Historically, the Interinsurance Exchange of the Automobile Club has provided law enforcement agencies with vehicles to be used in auto theft investigations. The Exchange proposes to provide to the RAID operation, for a two-year period, a 2003 Chrysler Town Country van (VIN 2C4GP343X3R167329 and 2000 Toyota 4Runner (VIN JT3HN86R4Y0323220). In accepting the vehicles, the County agrees to provide for the vehicles' insurance, maintenance and operating costs. All costs will be absorbed within the Department's status quo budget. The estimated cost for June 2005 is shown in the Financial Data section below.
