**SUBJECT:** Approval of the Sheriff's Participation in a Task Force to Provide Parcel Searches at the DHL Hub at March Reserve Air Force Base and the Adoption of Resolution 440-8595

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Amend Ordinance No. 440 pursuant to Resolution 440-8595 submitted herewith. Per the Resolution add the following positions:

2. Approve the purchase of two Orion mobile radios and two 800 MHz handie-talkie radios from the County Information Technology Department.

3. Approve the purchase of one plain vehicle and one Sports Utility Vehicle.

**BACKGROUND:** The world wide shipping company DHL expects to process approximately 230,000 parcels per day when it opens its parcel/package hub at the March Reserve Air Force Base. It is widely known in the law enforcement community that narcotics traffickers and money launderers use overnight parcel companies to make shipments containing controlled substances and illicit proceeds. Law enforcement agencies working with parcel companies have made seizures of controlled substances, hazardous materials and illegal proceeds.

With this new shipping hub commencing operation, the state Department of Justice, in cooperation with DHL, is forming a task force among federal, state and local allied agencies to provide parcel interdiction. As the task force coordinator, the state Bureau of Narcotics Enforcement has asked the Sheriff's Department to participate and assume the daily functional supervision of seven task force members from other law enforcement agencies. The Sheriff is proposing to provide a Sergeant to act as this command supervisor. In addition, the Sheriff is requesting a Deputy and a specially trained canine that will be dedicated to the task force.

The Sergeant will require a mid-size vehicle and the Deputy will require a SUV for transportation of the canine. The 800 MHz radio equipment specified conforms to selected County Technology Standards and will be purchased through the Information Technology Department.

Department staff has estimated that the Sheriff's participation on the task force will cost \$296,400 in FY 2005-06. During budget hearings, the Department will request the necessary funding for the FY 2005-06 budget.


