**SUBJECT:** Construction of Interim Asphalt Concrete Sidewalk, South Side of Mission Boulevard, Pedley Road to Valley Way, West Riverside Area

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the construction of interim asphalt concrete sidewalk on the South side of Mission Boulevard, from Pedley Road to Valley Way, in the West Riverside area of Riverside County. Add the project to the Transportation Improvement Program in accordance with Attachment "A". Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, June 29, 2005, at which time bids will be opened. Authorize the Director of Transportation to execute the contract documents, provided that the low responsive bid is within the project budget.

**BACKGROUND:** The Jurupa Unified School District is currently completing construction of their new High School which is located at the Southwest corner of Mission Boulevard and Camino Real. The School District intends to open the High School, Patriot High School, on September 8, 2005, as a temporary facility for Rubidoux High School, which is scheduled to be refurbished in coordination with the refurbishing of Mission Junior High School.

It is expected that the pedestrian high school students will utilize Mission Boulevard as their primary route to travel to and from the new high school. That section of Mission Boulevard currently does not have sidewalk improvements for most of the project limits.

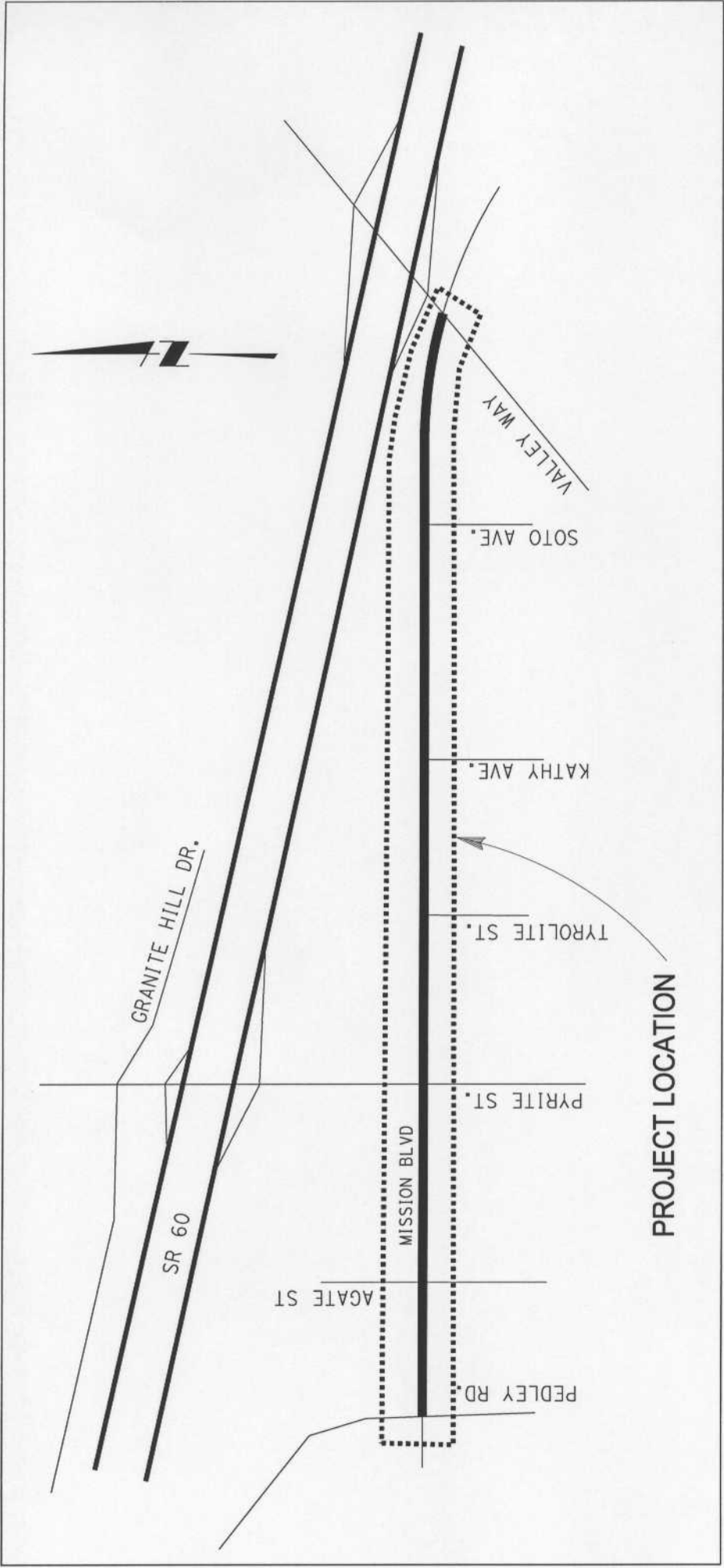
**RE: Construction of Interim Asphalt Concrete Sidewalk, South of Mission Boulevard,  
Pedley Road to Valley Way, West Riverside area**

With consideration of the short time-frame for providing pedestrian safety improvements for the opening of the new high school, the need for sidewalk on this major roadway should be considered an urgent matter. Execution of the contract documents by the Director of Transportation will allow the earliest start of construction, which is necessary for completion of the work by September 8, 2005. The construction agreement, construction bonds, summary of bids and a project status report will be subsequently submitted to the Board for receipt and filing. The project special provisions include a project schedule that specifies that construction will be completed by September 7, 2005.

The interim sidewalk improvements project will be funded by the Economic Development Agency. Construction is estimated at \$437,000, including contingencies. A funding agreement will be brought to the Board in the near future. The Transportation Department and the Economic Development Agency are also working on a joint improvement project to construct the ultimate improvements between Pedley Road and Kathy Way, to include street widening, curb and gutter and sidewalk. It has been determined that the ultimate improvements can not be completed prior to the opening of the new High School facility due to the much greater scope of the work, and associated right of way and utility issues.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
