BACKGROUND:

CDC is providing funding to counties as part of a statewide outreach campaign, Seniors Against Investment Fraud (S.A.I.F), designed to inform seniors on how to avoid investment scams and fraud schemes.

If approved, DPSS will utilize these funds to:

- Train volunteers who will educate seniors of Riverside County about these fraud scams; and
- Promote the S.A.I.F. program in partnership with appropriate local law enforcement and consumer groups.

The Board last approved a S.A.I.F. revenue agreement with the California Department of Corporations on January 25, 2005 (#3.32).

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The entire program is funded by CDC. No County funds are requested.
