The Soboba Band of Luiseno Indians has requested that the Riverside County Sheriff's Department provide law enforcement services on its reservation. On May 24, 2005, the Band executed a five-year Agreement for these services. Per the Agreement, the Sheriff's Department will dedicate two fully-supported Deputies to daily patrols on the reservation.

All personnel costs for this service addition will be fully recovered through the new Tribal rate, approved by the Board on May 3, 2005 (3.24). County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to form. Staff estimates the FY 2005-06 budget for this service addition will amount to \$273,200.

Due to the often rough terrain on the reservation, the Sheriff recommends the purchase of SUV's for Patrol vehicles. The 800 MHz radio equipment specified conforms to selected County Technology Standards and will be purchased through the Information Technology Department.
