**BACKGROUND:** DPSS-DCA conducted a countywide community needs assessment via phone with 486 residents from the previous needs assessment conducted in 2003. These residents had indicated they would participate in a follow-up survey; fifteen percent (15%) provided feedback. DPSS-DCA also conducted community meetings in each of the five Supervisorial Districts:

2/8/05	Coachella (District 4)
2/22/05	Perris (District 1)
3/3/05	Hemet (District 3)
3/23/05	Banning (District 5)
3/31/05	Corona (District 2)

Each of these meeting allowed additional input from the public. Their comments have been incorporated into the plan.

The 2006-07 plan relates how CSBG funding will be used to support programs and services as identified by the residents of low-income communities. CSBG funding to the County is \$1.9 million annually, and is used to leverage an additional \$7-8 million in matching resources.

A "Notice of Public Hearing" was published in the Press Enterprise and Desert Sun on Friday, June 10, 2005.

The Community Action Commission approved the 2006-07 Community Action Plan on May 26, 2005, and recommends the submission of the plan to the Board of Supervisors for approval.
