SUBJECT: Resolution 413-590 to Establish No-Stopping / Tow-Away Zones on Galena Street, Glen Avon area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution 413-590 to establish No-Stopping / Tow-Away Zones on Galena Street in the Glen Avon area every day between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m., as described in attached Resolution 413-590.

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Department was contacted by area business owners who are concerned about street racing on Galena Street, especially on Friday and Saturday nights. A large number of racers and spectators from Los Angeles and neighboring counties gather on the streets. The participants have not only endangered their own lives and the lives of others by the illegal street racing, but they have also vandalized and broken into properties of adjacent businesses.

Transportation Department staff reviewed this location in the field and determined that the proposed No-Stopping / Tow-Away Zones are appropriate. The tow-away zones will provide enforcement with an additional tool to discourage illegal street racing and loitering.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of these No-Stopping / Tow-Away Zones. The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed zones.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

10 On the south side of Galena Street starting at a point 50 feet east of the
11 centerline of Rutile Street to a point 3,915 feet east of said centerline, a total
12 distance of approximately 3,865 feet.

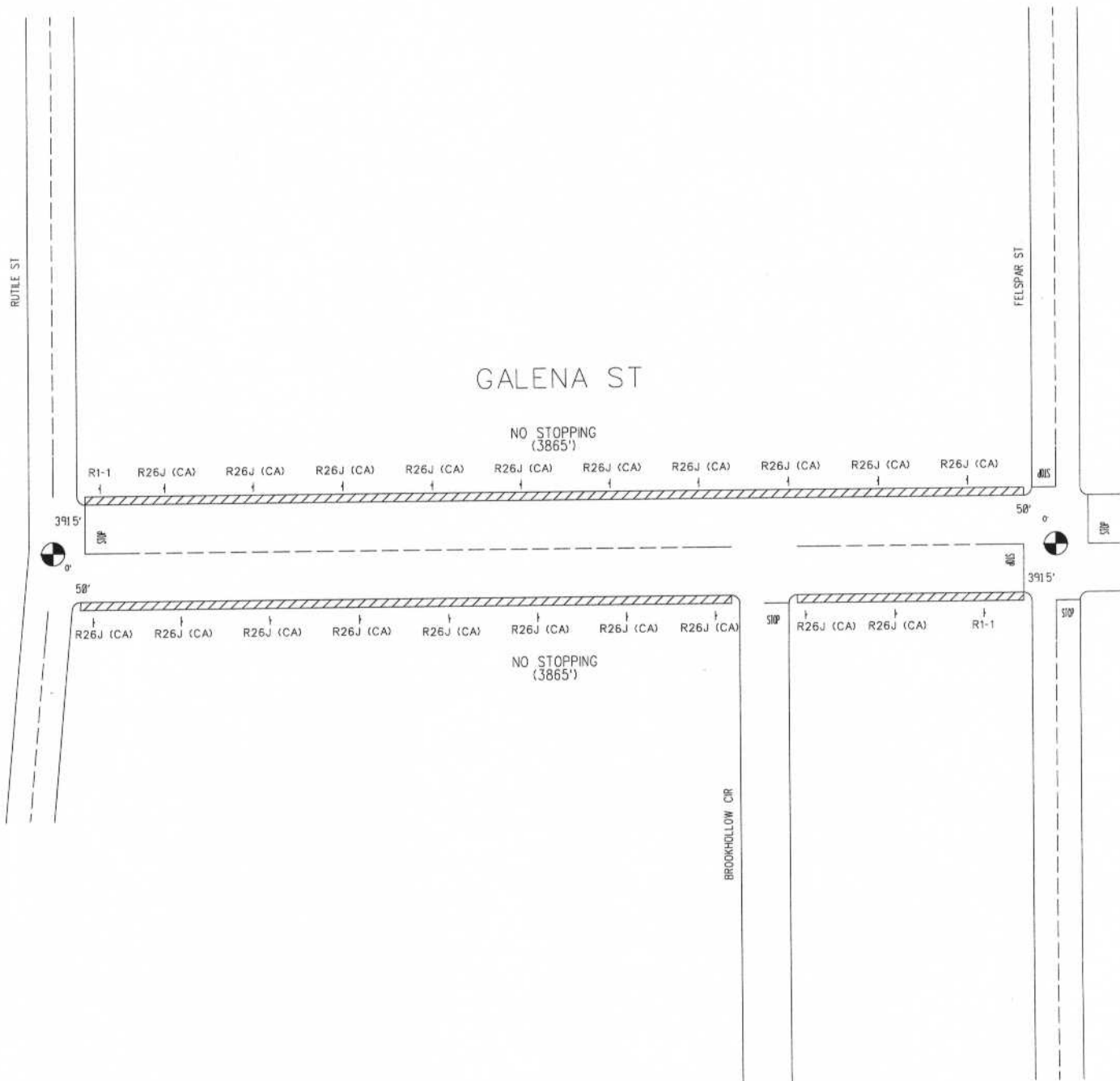

14 On the north side of Galena Street starting at a point 50 feet west of the
15 centerline of Felspar Street to a point 3,915 feet west of said centerline, a total
16 distance of approximately 3,865 feet.

20 and 5 a.m. every day.
