**SUBJECT:** First Amendment to Agreement with State Department of Health Services (DHS) Covering Fiscal Years 2004-05, 2005-06, and 2006-07 for Contracted County Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) Allowable for Federal Financial Participation (FFP)

**BACKGROUND:**

The existing Agreement with the State Department of Health Services (DHS) for contracted County Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) allows the County to receive Federal Financial Participation (FFP) for Medi-Cal Administrative Activities, via the State's Administrative Plan for eligible clients. Riverside County School Districts, referred to as Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) can also participate in the MAA program, receiving FFP for MAA activities. The Community Health Agency is acting as the single County Agency through which claims will be made under the Agreement. This contract amendment expands (Exhibit A) the Scope of Work section of the agreement to include MAA related services provided to an LEA by the Community Health Agency in its role as the coordinator of the MAA Program. The amendment also defines allowable MAA activities performed by an LEA.
