SUBJECT: FY 04/05 Volunteer Fire Assistance (VFA) Supplemental Grant

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board

- 1) Accept the FY 04/05 Volunteer Fire Assistance Supplemental Grant in the amount of \$285,700 to purchase fire communications and firefighting safety equipment;
- 2) Authorize the Fire Chief to sign Grant Agreement #7CA04-6; and
- 3) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to enter into fire and rescue equipment contracts up to the aggregate amount of \$285,700.

BACKGROUND: On December 14, 2004 (3.13), the Board authorized Riverside County Fire Department (RCOFD) to apply for the 04/05 Volunteer Fire Assistance Supplemental Grant to purchase fire communications and firefighting safety equipment. The grant request was approved and RCOFD received Grant Agreement #7CA04-6 on June 2, 2005. The grant provides funding in the amount of \$285,700 for Vega Viper Interoperability C-Soft consoles for incident deployment and firefighter high-pressure self-contained breathing apparatus.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION: The grant has a 75/25 cost share requirement as follows: 75% federal (\$214,275) and 25% non-federal (\$71,425). The match is included in the budget and consists of \$59,320 from Indian Gaming funding and \$12,105 from fire structural taxes. For match purposes, the Agreement should have a start date prior to end of the current fiscal year. However, all equipment would be purchased during the 05/06 fiscal year. Therefore, the required budget adjustment would be done in the First Quarter Report.
