SUBJECT: SEDCO MDP Line E (Project No. 3-0-0145) Cooperative Agreement

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside (County), the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) and the City of Lake Elsinore (City) and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: Mission Trail currently experiences significant ponding and drainage problems at the intersection of Lemon Street and Mission Trail resulting from overflow drainage coming off abutting properties along Lemon Street and from various storm events. In order to discharge the drainage it is necessary to construct storm drain improvements. Construction of these improvements will result in improved traffic safety and reduced roadway operation and maintenance costs.

Because of a lack of existing storm drain facilities in the vicinity it is necessary to construct an outlet that will discharge the excess drainage. The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the District will obtain right of way and contribute funding for the construction of a segment of the District's Sedco Master Drainage Plan Line E storm drain that is to be constructed by the Transportation Department. Upon completion of construction, the District will accept the mainline storm drain facility for ownership operation and maintenance.

The County will administer the construction contract and grant the District the necessary rights to construct, operate and maintain the project within County road right of way, and will assume responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the project's associated catch basins and laterals located within County road right of way.

The City of Lake Elsinore is granting the District the necessary rights to construct, operate and maintain the project within City road right of way.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to legal form and the original Agreement documents have been forwarded to the City for execution. A companion item appears on District's agenda this same date.
