**SUBJECT:** Adoption of Ordinance No. 843, Highgrove Sewer Discharge

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board introduce the first reading of Ordinance No. 843, an Ordinance of the County of Riverside regulating the discharge of waste into the public sewer system from the Highgrove Community.

**BACKGROUND:** On June 22, 2004 the Board approved agreements with the City of Riverside to provide wastewater treatment services for the unincorporated community of Highgrove (CSA 152C). Pursuant to these agreements, the County is required to adopt an ordinance to regulate discharge into the sewer system. The ordinance provides for the regulation and enforcement of activities in accordance with the federal government's objectives of general pretreatment regulations as stated in Section 403.2 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations and amendments thereto. The ordinance has been approved by County Counsel and the City of Riverside and it is recommended that the Board adopt the ordinance as proposed.
