SUBJECT: Amendment to the Capital Improvement Project (CIP) List to include the North Shore Community Center.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors amend the CIP list to allow for the addition of the North Shore Community Center with a project budget of \$150,000 from Redevelopment Agency funds.

BACKGROUND: The North Shore Community Center Project involves the installation in North Shore of the modular office building currently serving as the temporary Farmworker and Service Center in Mecca. Currently the community of North Shore does not have a dedicated location for community events. At present, arrangements have to be made with existing facilities that at times conflicts with other scheduled events.

Once the current occupants of the Mecca Farmworker Service Center move into their new facility the 3,200 square modular office building will be moved to Corvina Drive next to the Fire Station and used to provide a convenient and dedicated community facility for the North Shore Community Council and the community in general.

The total project budget for the North Shore Community Center will be paid from Redevelopment Agency funds and will not impact County general funds.

To expedite the process I am recommending that the CIP list be amended to include the North Shore Community Center.
