BACKGROUND: (Continued).

Chlamydia is the most reported communicable disease in California and Riverside County. It is estimated that close to 300,000 women and their partners are infected annually. The California Department of Health Services is awarding local health departments funds to promote Chlamydia screening and treatment of youth in detention centers in Riverside County. The Department of Public Health and Detention Health Services are collaborating on this project. This is an important strategy in the control of this silent epidemic.

The \$35,000 funding has been included in the Fiscal Year 2005/2006 budget which awaits approval by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors.

The additional \$35,000 will be allocated to Fiscal year 2006/2007.
