SUBJECT: Emergency Road and Culvert Repair, Pala Road, Apx. 1,000 Feet South of Pechanga Road at Pechanga Creek, Temecula area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors receive and file an emergency contract, with the firm of McLaughlin Engineering, that the Transportation Department has entered into on behalf of the County of Riverside, and extend the spending authority of the Director of Transportation up to the amount of \$325,000 with respect to that emergency contract.

BACKGROUND: The Director of Transportation has entered into an emergency contract with the firm of McLaughlin Engineering of Temecula, California, to perform emergency road and culvert repair work on Pala Road, apx. 1,000 feet south of Pechanga Road at Pechanga Creek in the Temecula area. The contract was executed, in accordance with authority that the Board has delegated to the Director of Transportation by Resolution no. 93-047, and has been approved as to legal form by County Counsel.

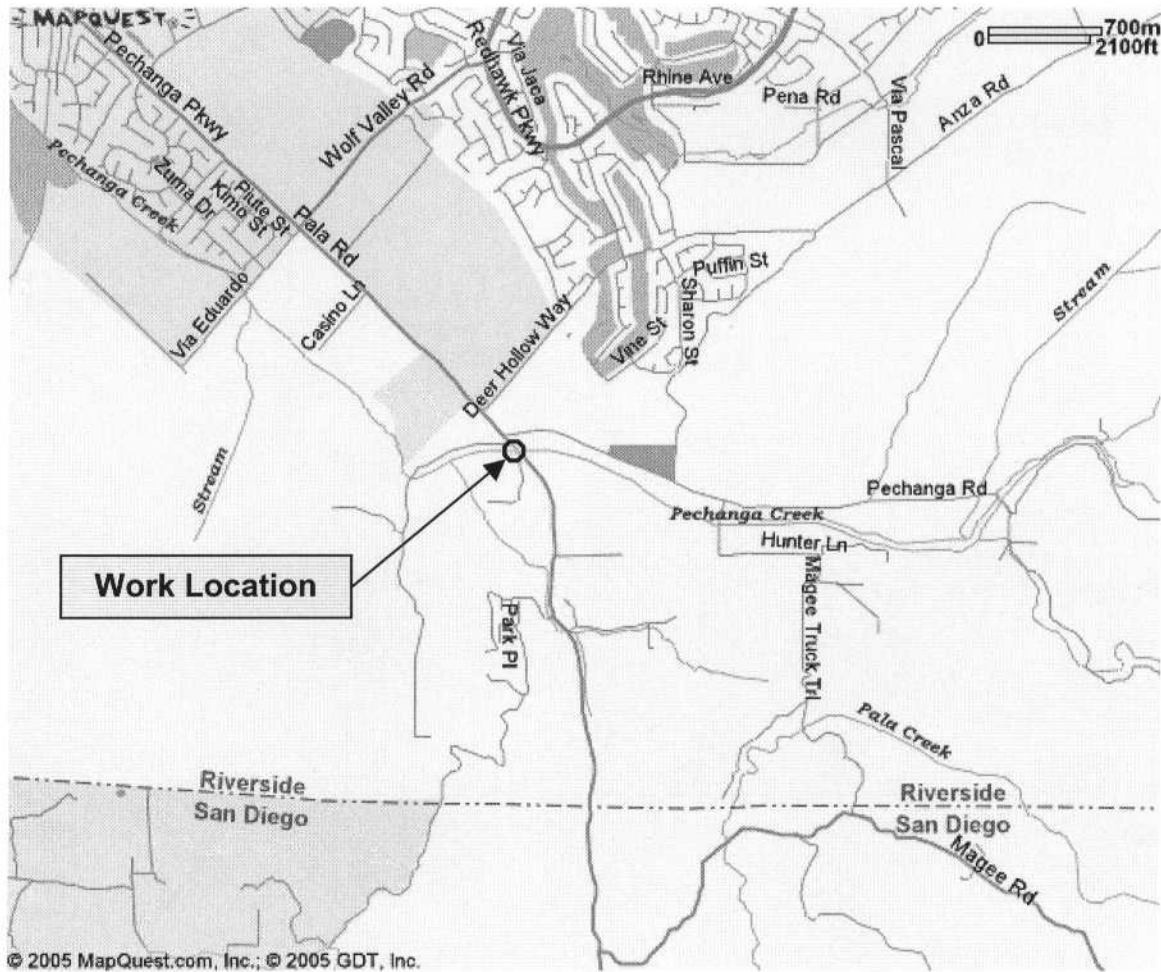

Storms caused damage to the road and culverts at the location where Pala Road crosses Pechanga Creek. Immediate repair of the damaged roadway and culverts was determined to be necessary to safeguard the motoring public. The initial emergency work started on January 14, 2005 and was completed on January 20, 2005. A subsequent storm required remobilization of the contractor at the same location. The work to repair damage from that second storm event started on February 21, 2005 and was completed on March 2, 2005. This second storm event increased the costs from the initial estimate of \$175,000 to an amount estimated at \$325,000, which exceeds the Transportation Director's emergency contract authority of \$300,000 as set forth in Resolution 93-047.

The work was performed in accordance with the Force Account provisions of the Standard Specifications. The work will be funded from Gas Tax. Board submittal is made at this time due to a delay in the receipt of the contract bonds from the contractor.

The Transportation Department is pursuing storm damage reimbursement funds for this work.
