SUBJECT: Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated,
Annexation of Street Lighting Zone 43

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BACKGROUND:

On June 14, 2005, a public hearing was held to receive all testimony regarding the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 43 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated ("L&LM Dist. No. 89-1-C"). After closing the public hearing, the Board directed the Director of Transportation, or his/her designee, to tally the assessment ballots that had been received prior to the close of the hearing. The assessment ballots were to be tabulated on June 15, 2005 at 10:00 a.m. in Conference Room B on the 8th Floor of the County Administrative Center. The tabulation shows that votes representing 5 parcels out of a possible 5 parcels was cast, and that 5 votes (or 100%) was cast in favor of the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 43 of L&LM Dist. No. 89-1-C and the levy and enrollment of the special assessment.

The proposed budget for fiscal year 2005-06 for Street Lighting Zone 43 is \$289.00 that will result in an assessment for fiscal year 2005-06 within Street Lighting Zone 43 of \$57.80 per parcel. Street Lighting Zone 43 includes 5 single family residential parcels.

Adoption of Resolution No. 2005-324 confirms the assessment levy as indicated in the Engineer's Report for fiscal year 2005-06 for Street Lighting Zone 43 of L&LM Dist. No. 89-1-C and orders the placement of the annual assessment on the County's Assessment Roll for fiscal year 2005-06.
