

SUBJECT: Methamphetamine Health and Safety Ordinance

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors introduce and on successive meeting adopt Ordinance 845, an Ordinance of the County of Riverside regarding the Health, Safety and Welfare of Community Victims of Methamphetamine Labs.

BACKGROUND:

The making of Methamphetamine, a dangerous drug, represents an unreasonable and deadly risk to our citizens, especially our greatest natural resource, our children. Therefore this Ordinance is written to protect our community by holding any person in violation of this Ordinance liable for all costs associated with the clean-up, consultation and rehabilitation of any structure(s) and/or property where the production or manufacturing of methamphetamine has taken place. Because the clean-up and residual rehabilitation of such structure(s) and properties involve health and safety concerns, the County Health Officer or their designee shall oversee such activities, including the re-occupancy of contaminated structure(s) and properties.




