**SUBJECT:** Resolution 413-591 to Establish a No-Stopping Zone on Goetz Road, Canyon Lake area

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board adopt Resolution 413-591 to establish a No-Stopping Zone on Goetz Road in the Canyon Lake area.

**BACKGROUND:** The Transportation Department was contacted by an area resident who is concerned about the daily parking of vehicles on Goetz Road by day laborers. There is a significant horizontal curve on Goetz Road at this location, and the dirt shoulder used for parking on Goetz Road is relatively narrow.

Transportation Department staff reviewed this location in the field and determined that the proposed No-Stopping Zone is appropriate, and will improve traffic operations and safety on this portion of Goetz Road.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of this No-Stopping Zone. The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Temecula Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed zone.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

8 Stopping Zone is hereby established in the Canyon Lake area:

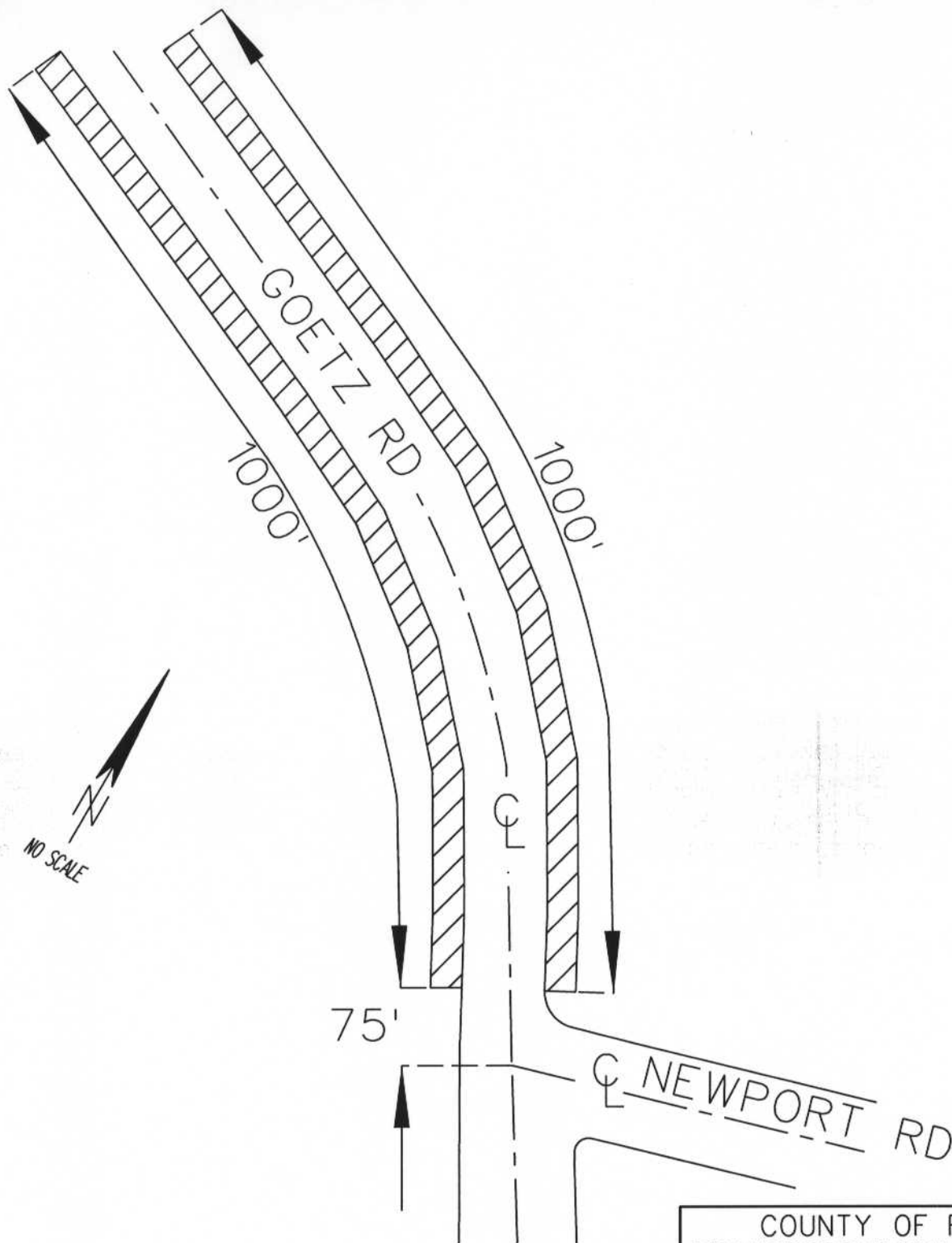
