SUBJECT: Resolution 413-594 to Establish No-Stopping Zones and a Passenger Loading/Unloading Zone, Woodcrest area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution 413-594 to establish No-Stopping Zones on Washington Street and Krameria Avenue, and a Passenger Loading/Unloading Zone on Krameria Avenue, in the Woodcrest area, as described in attached Resolution 413-594.

Also, that the Board rescind Resolution 413-330 for a No-Parking Zone on Washington Street and on Krameria Avenue, and a Passenger Loading Zone on Krameria Avenue.

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Department was contacted by representatives of the Woodcrest Municipal Advisory Council (WMAC) and the Woodcrest Elementary School regarding school traffic operation and congestion at the school.

Transportation Department staff conducted a field review of the site and met with school officials and the California Highway Patrol (CHP). It was determined that the proposed No-Stopping Zones and the Passenger Loading/Unloading Zone will improve sight distance for the school driveways, as well as improve pick-up/drop-off operation at/around the school. Both, school officials and the CHP, concurred with the proposed No-Stopping Zones and the Passenger Loading Zone.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of these No-Stopping Zones and Passenger Loading/Unloading Zone.

The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed zones.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

2 RESOLUTION NO. 413-594
3 ESTABLISHING NO-STOPPING ZONES
4 AND A PASSENGER LOADING/UNLOADING ZONE
5 IN THE WOODCREST AREA

6 BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of
7 Supervisors, County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session on
8 July 26, 2005, that pursuant to Ordinance No. 413, the following No-Stopping
9 Zones and Passenger Loading Zone are hereby established in the Woodcrest area:

10 No-Stopping Zones

11 On the east side of Washington Street starting at a point 22 feet north of the
12 centerline of Krameria Avenue to a point 202 feet north of said centerline, a total
13 distance of approximately 180 feet.

14
15 The above No-Stopping Zone shall be in effect between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.,
16 and 2:30 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. on school days.

17
18 On the west side of Washington Street starting at a point 195 feet north of the
19 centerline of Krameria Avenue to a point 53 feet north of said centerline, a total
20 distance of approximately 142 feet.

21
22 On the north side of Krameria Avenue starting at a point 179 feet west of the centerline
23 of Washington Street to a point 364 feet west of said centerline, a total distance of
24 approximately 185 feet.

1 On the north side of Krameria Avenue starting at a point 656 feet west of the centerline
2 of Washington Street to a point 787 feet west of said centerline, a total distance of
3 approximately 131 feet.
4

5 Passenger Loading/Unloading Zone

6 On the north side of Krameria Avenue starting at a point 66 feet west of the centerline
7 of Washington Street to a point 179 feet west of said centerline, a total distance of
8 approximately 113 feet.
9

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that Resolution
11 No. 413-330, heretofore adopted by this Board of Supervisors on September 19, 1995, for No-
12 Parking Zones on the westerly side of Washington Street and on the northerly side of Krameria
13 Avenue, and a Passenger Loading Zone on the northerly side of Krameria Avenue, is hereby
14 rescinded.
