**BACKGROUND:** The Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved funding from the California Emergency Medical Services Authority on January 25, 2005, Item 3.4, in the amount of \$31,801 for the performance period of July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005. This funding is to complete the *Statewide Evaluation of Emergency Medical Services for Children (EMSC) Project*.

**SUBJECT:** Approve the First Amendment to the Agreement with the California Emergency Medical Services Authority (EMSA)

**BACKGROUND** continued:

Due to unforeseen delays, the development of a sub-contract with Los Angeles BioMedical Research Institute (LABioMed) at Harbor UCLA Medical Center has not been finalized. LABioMed will complete the majority of project activities that will determine the statewide status of the development, implementation and sustainability of EMSC into local Emergency Medical Services Agencies. The impact of this study will evaluate the utilization of emergency services and systems for critically ill and injured children.

This Amendment will only extend the performance period through December 31, 2005 to allow LABioMed to complete the project activities.

This Amendment has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
