1. Ratify and Authorize Chair to execute Title III & VII Contract, Amendment 2 for FY 2004-2005 (July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2005) with the California Department of Aging (CDA).
2. Return all copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

BACKGROUND: This agreement was originally approved on June 15, 2004 as Agenda Item 3.1 and amended on February 15, 2005 as Agenda Item 3.4. Funds provided under this Agreement support the provision of services, programs and other activities for senior citizens Countywide in accordance with Title III & VII of the Older Americans Act and The Older Californians Act. The services include Supportive Services and Senior Centers (IIIB) Congregate and Home Delivered Nutrition (IIIC & NSIP), Preventive Health and Medication Management (IIID), National Family Caregiver Support (IIIE), Long Term Care Ombudsman Services (VII-a), Elder Abuse Prevention (VII-b) and Community Based Service Programs (Brown Bag, Alzheimer's Day Care Resource Centers, Senior Companion, Linkages, and Respite Purchase of Service) as developed in our
