BACKGROUND: This Agreement between the County of Riverside, on behalf of the Riverside County Regional Medical Center (Hospital) and the California Perinatal Quality Care Collaborative (CPQCC), establishes the link for the reporting of hospital-level performance data of services provided in the Hospital's Perinatal and Neonatal Intensive Care Units.

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BACKGROUND (Continued):

CPQCC was appointed as an outgrowth of an initiative supported by the State of California Department of Health Services, Maternal and Child Health Branch, and the California Association of Neonatologists. This collaborative aims to improve the health of pregnant women, infants and children by collecting high quality information on perinatal outcomes and resource utilization, which will allow for performance improvement and benchmarking processes in perinatal care and intensive care units. The Hospital's participation with CPQCC is a condition of participation with the California Children's Services (CCS) Program.

This Agreement has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel.
