**SUBJECT:** Ratify the First Amendment to the Agreement between the County of Riverside and the State of California Emergency Medical Services Authority (EMSA) for the Implementation of Disaster Medical System (DMS) Planning Project.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the First Amendment to the Agreement with the State of California Emergency Medical Services Authority (EMSA) that details a reduction in funding by \$43,000 and an extension of the performance period to December 31, 2005 for the Implementation of Disaster Medical System Planning Project; and
- 2) Authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to sign seven (7) original copies of the Agreement.

**BACKGROUND:** On November 23, 2004 (item 3.6) the Board of Supervisors approved a block grant from EMSA in the amount of \$86,450 to develop and integrate the eight Emergency Medical Services (EMS) functions of the Disaster Medical Systems guidelines into the County's Emergency Operations Plan (EOP). This integration will improve overall disaster planning by allowing pre-hospital providers, hospitals,

In May, 2005 the Department of Public Health (DOPH) was notified by EMSA that the funding for our Agreement was reduced by \$43,000 due to cuts in block grants at the state and federal levels.
